## ***Information Pertaining To Road Usage***

To ensure the safety of the people who will be participating, we have been granted permission by the City of Kingston for road usage. The event's activities will be based from Confederation Park/City Hall on Ontario Street. The city has approved several temporary street closures that will be in effect on race day from 4:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. See details below. Kingston Police will manage intersections allowing the right-of-way to cyclists and runners. Traffic will be able to move but will be delayed from 7:00am to 2:00pm. If alternate routes are available, motorists are encouraged to use them. If not, Kingston Police will do their best to accommodate your travel. Please use extreme caution travelling these routes for overall safety. We can assure you that local residents and businesses will still have access. There may be times when there will be a short delay of up to a few minutes but we are working closely with the Police to minimize any wait times.

If you need access to a street blocked by a barricade where there is no volunteer we suggest you slide the barricade over and drive around it and replace the barricade as you found it. Your assistance in this is important in order to make the area safe for athletes and residents.

## ***Information pertaining to Lasalle Causeway***

The Lasalle Causeway Lift Bridge will remain down from 8:30am to 12:30pm to allow cyclists to cross the bridge safely. A notice to boaters will be issued. Motorists will still have access to the bridge.
